Coleson Cluster Board meeting convened at 7 p.m. (ET)

The board discussed how to get the word out to residents who want to coordinate with Growing Earth to get their own trees trimmed when Growing Earth comes out to do work on cluster trees in May. The board decided to send out an e-mail notifying residents of the opportunity and providing Growing Earth's number. (This was done.)

The board discussed how best to assess the structures of the carports. Vern said he would contact the county, which might be able to do the assessment for free.

The minutes for the previous meeting were approved. Jeff made the motion and Will seconded it.

The board is interested in tracking down energy saver bulbs for the Dominion lights. Dominion says it does not have options right now but the board agreed it would keep an eye out for newer energy savings options such as the LED technologies coming up.

Laura mentioned that there is interest in a community yard sale.

Vern moved to pass the proposed budget for FY2011. Harris seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Harris mentioned that some residents had expressed concern about mosquitoes and suggested that the cluster throw mosquito disks on the carport roofs if there is a drainage problem.
