1. Welcome & Call to Order

2. Treasure's Update and Financial Report, Jonathan

3. Landscape Updates, Mary

Goal: The Landscape Working Group (LWG) is an ongoing volunteer collective of Coleson Cluster Board Members and residents who work together to support the maintenance and beautification of common areas in and around the Cluster. The LWG will act as an advisory to the Board on addressing landscaping needs, and the use of sustainable best practices that promote eco-friendly and beneficial environments.

Action Items: 8/20/25, 6pm. Meeting with Tucker Newberry and Liz Cohen representing PRIZM a volunteer partner of Plant NOVA Natives (another volunteer Not-for-Profit). Attendees: Mary, Tucker, Liz. Discussion: Walkthrough and inventory of plants along Wainwright and down the RA Green Path, along the north side of the Cluster. Feedback was provided on the extent of invasives and the number of existing beneficial natives.

Invasive Species Control Grant offered by PRIZM

- Pre-App due Oct 15, formal App due on Nov 1, Awards announced on Nov 8.
- April deadline to complete work. Try to pair with Spring Cleanup.
- Award is for \$3,000 with 50% match, either a \$1,500 monetary match or work hours at \$34/hr (45 hrs).
- Potential consultation with Nature by Design in Alexandria.

2025 LWG Summary

Portions of Areas 1 & 2 (the bank in front of #1660 - #1664)

- ✓ At #1660, added more pollinators plants (e.g., clethera, hyssop, phlox, asters, speedwell, mountain mint varieties, cone flower, butterfly weed, etc.)
- ✓ At #1664, removed ivy, added pollinators (e.g., false indigo, hosta, spirea).
- ☐ In progress—at #1666, removed ivy, weeded, and installed liriope, hosta, heuchera and climbing aster.

Area 6 (the area around Carport #9)

- ✓ Suspected hosta X virus in the soil. **NO HOSTAS** to be planted in this area until next year.
- ✓ Shenandoah removed privet root ball and added new mulch.
- □ In progress—at #1640: removed ivy groundcover and overgrown privet. Will continue to work on removing vinca around Japanese maple, but for now cut back and gave it a decorative form. Trimmed azaleas and viburnum. Installed pollinators (e.g., clethra, phlox, aster, coneflowers). Looking to install a stone footpath and feature.

4. Tree Work, Greg

Goal: Continuous and ongoing Capital Improvement Project to provide a safe and sustainable environment by maintaining the existing tree canopy in and around the Cluster. Tree removal and pruning is prioritized to protect people, pathways and property.

Action Item. Greg to reconcile current invoicing from Blade Runners who provided summer/fall tree removal work (original quote for \$13,977).

- Blade Runners has completed tree service in the Cluster for the time being. Next work order will take place in the Spring.
- Greg will be departing from the Cluster Board. Carl to continue Cluster tree maintenance coordination.

5. Board Meeting Minute Approvals
